



SRI LANKA STUDY TOUR 6 – 16 March 2025

Payment

A non-refundable 40% deposit is required by Sunday, 5 January 2025

Final Payment must be made by Monday, 20 January 2025

What is included?

- 10 nights of 4 * and 5 * Star Hotel Accommodation
- · All breakfasts and dinners, plus most lunches
- Transport in a private, air-conditioned 33-seater coach
- English speaking guides
- Private arrival and departure transfers from the airport to the hotel
- All government taxes
- All hotels have Wi-Fi, Laundry Service and en-suite bathrooms

What is not included?

- Personal consumables such as alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages, laundry, etc.
- Travel Insurance
- Health Insurance
- Lunches when specified

- International flights
- Visas
- Early check-in or late check-out
- Local mobile SIM card
- Any services not mentioned above

You are responsible for your own international travel to and from Australia.

Health Notes

Please contact your local GP regarding advice on innoculations and other health matters on visiting Sri Lanka.

We strongly recommend that you consider having vaccinations before you travel. At least eight weeks before you depart, make an appointment with your doctor or travel clinic for a basic health check-up, and to discuss your travel plans and any implications for your health, particularly if you have an existing medical condition.

Visas

To enter Sri Lanka, you'll need a visa in the form of an <u>Electronic Travel Authorisation</u> (<u>ETA</u>). You should do this before you travel, as there are limited facilities to obtain an ETA on arrival at Colombo's Bandaranaike International Airport: <u>https://eta.gov.lk/</u>

Members are responsible for obtaining their ETAs.

Insurance

AllA Victoria requires all Members of the Study Group to obtain comprehensive travel and health insurance to obtain a place on the Tour. Your policy needs to cover all overseas medical costs, including medical evacuation. The Australian Government won't pay for these costs.
